ECOLOGICAL BUILDING WITH STRAWBALES

Building with Strawbales is a modern green building technique in fast evolution. Houses mainly made out of straw, wood and clay provide a protective, warm, durable and healthy environment to live in. Participants will gain basic knowledge about constructional physics, planning principles, building codes, main construction methods, construction site management and more. By working practically you will learn how to use strawbales and apply different types of earthen plasters to form perfect walls, floors and ceilings. We will study different existing examples in the ecovillage of Sieben Linden. The course is appropriate for experienced builders as well as beginning learners.
