OBJECTIVES:

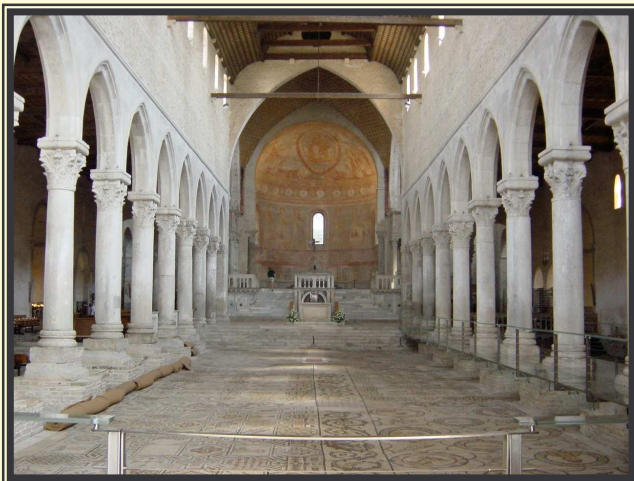
To recover typical European traditional techniques of lime used for centuries to build and decorate.
